RE: 2018-2019 Tuition Aid Process

For the second year, our Tuition Aide application / award process will be through FACTS Management, accessed through the Diocesan website. Some Basic Information about the 2018-2019 Tuition Aid Process includes the following:

- The Family Application Fee will be \$25.00, same as last year.
- For the 2018-2019 school year, paper applications will not be available. All applications must be completed online. The FACTS support team will provide any assistance needed to families using the online application process for the first time.
- The application deadline is ***March 15, 2018***. If individual families have extenuating circumstances in meeting this deadline, the Diocese will be as flexible as possible in accommodating your needs.
- The Pastor Signature Form required for the Bishop's Education Fund grant, previously only available on the Diocesan website, will also be available within the online application for families. This form will need to be signed by the pastor and uploaded to FACTS.
- Families will again be notified by email to log into their account to view their aid awards.
- If emergencies arise after initial grants are disbursed, families are free to address an email to Dr. Michael Latusek, Superintendent of Schools at budplan@diopitt.org.

As in past years, the following aid funds will be available to families, depending upon your eligibility:

- **Bishop's Education Fund** – For Catholic Families with students in grades K-12. Must complete Pastor Signature form.
- **Educational Improvement Tax Credit Program (EITC)** – Open to any student in grades Pre-School to 12 from families who meet the EITC income guidelines.
- **Opportunity Scholarship Tax Credit Program (OSTC)** – Open to any student in grades K-12 who meet the EITC income guidelines and would be attending a low achieving public school as defined by the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania.
