Old Business:

- *Treasurer's Report* - No current information is available at this time.
- Catholic Schools Week - Lunch, mass and School Events well attended.
- Talent Show - (Rena Kim reported) Well attended and made profit of \$800.70. Possible items to add to enhance the stage area - Spot Light, speaker, and sound system.
- Service Project - 32 families donated money that was used to help provide food to the Light of Life Mission. Possible future plans to do a yearly donation/volunteer day and involve students from 8th grade.
- Family Valentines Dance - (Liz Marston, Matthew Jenkins, Becky Yuhas & Tabitha Dillon, reported). The dance was well attended by over 30 families/70+ people attended. DJ, dancing, candy bar, photo wall and desserts were at the dance.

New Business:

- A request has been made for the purchase of recess items - Balls and jump ropes. (Longer jump ropes for double dutch) Members voted and it was passed. The PTG will purchase the items.
- With the new recess equipment to be purchase and current equipment, there's a need to look into the purchase of a storage container that can be kept near the top parking lot, to ease in the transportation of the equipment. Matthew Jenkins will look into options.
- Teacher Appreciation Luncheon - Will be on Friday, May 25th. Cara Piagessi is chair and she has secured North Side Deli to cater the meal. Desserts will be from the Priory.
- A request was made for the PTG to donate a \$50 gift card to the Festival for the Chinese auction booth. This item was discussed and it was voted down by members of the PTG. Funds should be used to benefit the students and student activities.
- School Garden - The first year of the garden was a success. - Beds were made, Vegetables were planted and they grew over the summer. Some school classes participated with the garden. Going in to the second year, what are the plans for the

garden? How will the school use the garden? What classes will be involved? Is there a need to expand it or keep the same? Possible items to purchase- hose for ease of watering the garden. Mr. Munz will check with teacher to see who would like to participate again and how they will participate.

- Middle School Dance- Possible dates May 11th or 12th- Tabitha Dillon will chair and Liz Marston will contact DJ.
- Paint Party- date TBD possible in April – Tasha Leslie is chair.
- Future fundraiser- “Dinner out” nights at local restaurants. On select nights, the profits from sales at the restaurant are given to schools. Rena Kim and Becky Yuhas will call local restaurants and see if that is possible to do.
- Future Fundraising ideas- Have bigger fundraisers to replace smaller ones- Suggestions- Coach Bingo and Cash Bash. Possibly doing two big PTG fundraisers for next year. These will need looked into and voted on.
